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- The KFT program provides ongoing in-home case management, in-home family counseling along with stable housing. Each case will be reviewed weekly to explore each family's need.
- Families will receive a project-based Housing Choice Voucher and will have access to 2 and 3-bedroom units across 4 identified properties. Families will also receive a one-time start up assistance to help with furnishing the home and utilities.
- KFT staff will collaborate with families to identify their goals and create a CARE plan.
- All KFT staff will work flexible hours, days, evenings, and weekends in order to meet the needs of KFT families. Designated staff will be on-call 24-7.
- KFT staff will provide assistance with transportation, food vouchers, etc. as needed.
- KFT staff will provide transportation for families when needed to get to and from medical appointments and overall concrete needs such as; board of social services, WIC, food banks, Social Security, etc.
- KFT staff works closely with the Division of Child Protection and Permanency, Department of Community Affairs, landlords and other stakeholders to support positive family relationships.
- KFT staff will help with building effective relationships, developing positive parenting skills, seeking affordable medical care, household management, organizational skills, creating structure and routine, providing a safe family environment, managing family finances, and linkages to community resources.
- KFT staff will identify any trauma-related needs and help to address them by educating and coaching caregivers and children on calming techniques to deal with stress, self-care strategies, and how to connect with support groups.
- KFT staff will meet with each family a minimum of 1 time per week, however can meet more frequently based on the family's needs.
